

Year 6 Homework

Each week in Year 6, the following homework will be set:

- **Spellings:** A spelling list of words for the half term will be sent home at the beginning of each term. These will be broken down into weekly spellings, which will be tested on Thursday each week.
- **Maths:** A piece of maths homework will be set each week. It may be a worksheet or some allocated activities on Abacus. This will be sent home on a Friday and will be expected in on the following Wednesday.
- **English or Topic:** Some weeks a piece of English or topic work will also be sent home on a Friday and expected in on the following Wednesday.

Please note that each maths, English or topic task should take approximately 30 mins to complete, although on occasions, project work may be set which the children will have a longer period of time to complete.

- **Reading:** Children should be reading for at least 20-30 minutes each evening. This should be from a range of texts e.g. fiction/non-fiction/newspaper articles/magazines etc.
- **Times Tables:** Children should be encouraged to practise their multiplication tables and related division facts regularly.
Please note that children are expected to be fluent with all their times tables up to 12 x 12 by the end of Year 4.

Please support children with their homework wherever necessary.

If children do not understand the task, they should inform their teacher on **Monday** so that the teacher can support them.

Additional homework/SATs preparation:
